

Since first launch in May 2016, over 30 thoracic experts throughout the world have joined VATS Editorial Board, and More will come.








3. Geographical Distribution of Editorial Board Members




Since first launched in May 2016, VATS altogether published **34** articles in 2016, with diverse article types.


